

Associate of Arts in Elementary Education for Transfer (AOAELEMEDU - Transfer)

Program Description

The Associate of Arts in Elementary Education prepares students for transfer into Arizona public university education programs. In order to successfully complete this degree, students must maintain a C grade point average or higher for all coursework. This degree also meets official Arizona Professional Teacher Standards as well as fulfilling the requirements for elementary school paraprofessional teacher's aide certification.

TOCC Recommends

Students pursuing the Associate of Arts in Elementary Education (also known as an AA-EE) degree should meet with their TOCC advisors every semester. Completion of this degree does not guarantee admission to selective college of education programs. Students seeking to guarantee their admission to the Arizona public university of their choice should complete an AGEC-A while pursuing coursework applicable to the AA-EE.

In order to complete an AA-EE with the best preparation, students intending to transfer as a junior should contact the appropriate university department or college upon completion of the AGEC-A.

Before Beginning the AA-EE

Before enrolling in AGEC courses, students must pass REA 091 or achieve a comparable COMPASS score.
